DPDP for Clinics, Hospitals & Labs

Patient data is the most sensitive data a business can hold. Duties start at one digital patient record — practice size doesn't matter.

Where Patient Data Lives

- Appointment app / EMR / billing
- WhatsApp chats & report PDFs
- Lab portals & insurance files
- Reception forms that get typed in (S.3)

Your Duties

- Notice at intake, patient's language (S.5(3), R.3)
- Share only what treatment needs
- Lab & software contracts need DP terms (S.8(2))
- Keep records per medical norms, then delete (S.8(7))

Do This Now

- QR code at reception → multilingual notice
- Route patient requests to one owner (S.11–12)
- Write the breach plan (R.7: 72 hours)
- Paediatric patients → verifiable parental consent (S.9, R.10)

Watch Out

- Children's data: ₹200 Cr tier — routine in healthcare
- Shared clinic phones leak patient chats
- A leaked patient list is a serious breach
- Sectoral medical-record rules apply alongside DPDP
