DPDP for Hotels

Every hotel entering guest details into software is a Data Fiduciary — ID, travel and payment data all count.

■ The Guest Data Trail

- Name, nationality, date of birth
- Government ID / passport & visa
- Address, phone, email, travel dates
- Payment info, preferences, CCTV footage

■ The Dual-Track Duty

- Foreigner passport/visa → Form C to FRRO (other law)
- DPDP governs how you use that data after
- No marketing use of ID data without consent
- Consent notice at check-in

■ PMS & Security

- Role-based PMS access + admin 2FA
- Encrypt Aadhaar / passport data
- Access logs for guest records
- CCTV notices + defined retention (e.g. 30 days)

■ Watch Out

- Complying with one law ≠ a pass under DPDP
- Loyalty programmes need separate consent
- Review DPAs with OTAs (MakeMyTrip, Booking.com...)
- Small hotels face the same obligations
